The BICC is very proud to unveil a new trophy and a new cup, to commemorate and celebrate the lives of two people who have made significant contributions to the club over many decades.

The trophy is to commemorate the life and contribution made to the BICC by its former President, John Tyerman. Named, **The John Tyerman Memorial Trophy**, it is 19.4 inches high with a handle width of 13.5 inches. It stands on a base of solid Albizia silk wood and is antique sterling silver, with a cover hallmarked London 1904 made by Barnard & Sons. It will be presented to the winner of the best average for all of the Old Bird National races.
